

# The North Lambton Community Health Centre

The North Lambton Community Health Centre is a community governed health centre serving identified priority populations in a defined catchment area. The Centre operates multiple sites in **Forest, Kettle & Stony Point, Watford, and Sarnia, Ontario**. Our interdisciplinary team of providers includes: physicians, nurse practitioners, registered nurses, social workers, health promoters, dietitians and physiotherapists.

As part of the Afterschool Strategy, funded by the Ministry of Tourism, Culture and Sport, the North Lambton Community Health Centre requires the following contract positions from September 2019 until June 2020:

- (9) Youth Leaders – up to 9 hours/week**

The Program Leaders and Youth Leaders will work closely together in planning, developing, implementing and evaluating the Afterschool Strategy Program. This program is offered afterschool at four different locations in the rural communities of Forest, Thedford, Watford and the First Nations community of Kettle Point. The focus of the program is to provide physical activity and healthy living education to school aged children and youth from grades 1-8 after school.

- A Degree or Diploma in Health Promotion or Child and Youth Worker or Early Childhood Educator, or a related discipline.
- Experience facilitating programs for children and youth aged 6-13 years.
- Strong communication and group facilitation skills.
- Basic computer skills with proficiency in Microsoft Word, Excel, Power Point and Publisher.
- A valid driver's license and access to a reliable vehicle.
