The North Lambton Community Health Centre is a community governed health centre serving identified priority populations in a defined catchment area. The Centre operates multiple sites in Ontario: **Forest, Kettle & Stony Point, Watford, and Sarnia**. Our interdisciplinary team provides primary health care, health promotion and community development services.

The North Lambton Community Health Centre is currently seeking applicants for the following position:

Registered Social Worker 6 Month Contract – Harm Reduction Team 37.5 Hours/Week

The Registered Social Worker (RSW) provides educational and psycho-social support to people infected with or at risk of contracting Hepatitis C. Working with a care team focused on the needs of people significantly marginalized by poverty, addiction, mental health and housing issues, this SW will provide a range of interventions to assist people living with Hepatitis C to cope with their chronic illness, social difficulties and side effects of treatment. This will include street outreach services, counselling, psycho-social assessments, consultation, education and advocacy for clients and families/supports, as well as educational services for staff and/or volunteers, as required.

Qualifications:

- Current registration with the Ontario College of Social Workers and Social Service Workers and a member in good standing;
- Bachelor or Master of Social Work from an accredited university;
- Three to five years' experience in a community setting or combination of community and hospital; experience in a primary care setting is an asset;
- Awareness of and understanding of the social determinants of health and harm reduction;
- Ability to work with diverse communities with respect, sensitivity, creativity, innovation, cultural understanding, non-judgement and facilitation skills;
- Ability to maintain complete and accurate records in accordance with the Centre's policies;
- Strong computer skills, including the use of MS Office products and Electronic Medical Records.

This position enjoys a supportive environment with flexible hours, 37.5 hours per week Monday to Friday. The rate of pay for this temporary full-time contract position is \$32.78 - \$38.93 per hour (on a six-step grid) plus 10% in lieu of benefits. The rate will be based on experience and education. Flexible hours of work. HOOPP enrollment is available.
